 - Furnace, Hot water tank, Electric, and Plumbing

Home Repair PROGRAM

Home Repair Qualifications

- > Applicant must own and occupy the home.
- > Applicant must be current on all property taxes and their mortgage.
- > Applicant should be willing to volunter with sweat equity.
- > Applicant must be willing to pay back a portion of the repair cost.
- > Applicant's monthly income must fall within the following guidelines:

2022 Home Repair Income Guidelines 80% AMI
Monthly Max.

(2) FAMILY OF TWO	\$5,000
(3) FAMILY OF THREE	\$5,625
(4) FAMILY OF FOUR	\$6,246

(7) FAMILY OF SEVEN	\$7,746
(8) FAMILY OF EIGHT	\$8,246
(9) FAMILY OF NINE	\$8,746
(10) FAMILY OF TEN	\$9,246

FAQs

How long does the process take from application to completion?

It can take between 6-months to a year.

What will my payback be?

Your payback amount is determined by your income level. Habitat MidOhio calculates your percentage of payback on a sliding scale.

What is Sweat Equity?

Habitat uses the term "sweat equity" to refer to the hours of labor our homeowners and home repair partners dedicate to building and/or repairing their homes, as well as the time they spend investing in their own self-improvement.

Six steps to repair:

- > Apply
- > Financial Approval
- > Construction Assessment & Approval
- > Partnership Agreement
- > Down Payment
